



52nd ANNUAL STATE AERIE EAGLES BOWLING TOURNAMENT 2009
USBC Moral Support Certified

1. Entrants in this tournament are restricted to Nebraska Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie only, and who are members in good standing.
2. Bowlers will use last year's USBC certified highest final league book average for the 2007-2008 season (rule 319a). If a bowler does not have a last year's average, he will use this year's highest average of 21 games or more as of January 31, 2009. If no average, the bowler will use an average of 170. If the bowler's current average is 10 pins or more higher in 21 games than last year as of March 24, 2008 (319a #2) he must use his current average. USBC Rule 319c will also be used. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in more handicap rule (rule 319a #3.)
3. Prize money returned 100%. Prize winnings will be returned 1 in every 6 entries in team, 1 in every 6 for doubles/singles and 1 to 10 for all events. All events will be handicapped.
4. Handicap is 80% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200. Handicap figures individual for team, doubles and singles.
5. USBC and non USBC member may participate in this tournament with score recognition. Non members may purchase an associate membership card for a \$21.00 fee (300c). You must sanction before you begin bowling.
6. Team captains will report to the tournament office 30 minutes prior to starting time.
7. A traveling state team award will be presented for the high score with handicap and scratch.
8. Championship Trophies will be awarded to the High Scratch Scores. Prize money will be awarded to high scores, including handicap.
9. Multiple entries will not be permitted. If necessary a local bowler will be allowed to bowl for another bowler who for some reason is not able to bowl; but first appearance will count for All-Events.
10. Bowlers must enter both doubles and singles. Both will be bowled at scheduled time.
11. Tournament offices will check all averages before awarding prize money and awards. Any errors in scoring must be reported within 23 hours.
12. Tournament prizes winning need be reported. We reserve the right to split squads.
13. All Aerie membership cards will be checked before any are allowed to bowl. Team captains are responsible for making sure all bowlers are paid up at the time they bowl. If the bowler is unable to provide the card, or is delinquent, he will not be allowed to bowl and will not receive a refund.
14. A bowler may bowl Team, Doubles and Singles all in one day.
15. The State Tournament officials shall have charge of all entry fees and determine how the tournament prize winnings and expense fees shall be disbursed.
16. All checks must be postmarked by February 20, 2009. **All entries must be paid in full upon receipt of application.** Make checks payable to **Eagles State Bowling, Aerie # 4029 Fraternal Order of Eagles.**
